Notice 1037 of 1999

MINISTRY FOR INTELLIGENCE

Notice of intention table the Intelligence Services Control Amendment Bill, 1999, in Parliament, as an urgent Bill, during the week of 30 August to 3 September 1999:

- 1. The Amendment Bill seeks to achieve the following objectives:
 - **1.1** To align the conditions of service of the Inspector-General of Intelligence with those of the Public Protector;
 - 1.2 to align the procedure for the appointment of the Inspector-General of Intelligence with the procedure stipulated in section 210 (b) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996), which requires approval by a resolution adopted by the National Assembly with a supporting vote of at least two thirds majority of its members;
 - **1.3** to change the composition of the Joint Standing Committee on Intelligence by changing the formula for the appointment of members of Parliament to the Committee;
 - **1.4** to provide for a security clearance for members-elect of the Joint Standing Committee on Intelligence.
