REMUNERATION OF PUBLIC OFFICE BEARERS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 20 OF 1998): DETERMINATION OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS, MEMBERS OF PROVINCIAL HOUSES OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS AND MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL HOUSE OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS FOR THE 2003/2004 FINANCIAL YEAR

Under section 5(1) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998), I hereby –

- (a)
 - (i) after consultation with the Premiers concerned;
 - (ii) after taking into consideration the matters listed in paragraphs (a) to (h) of section 5(1) of that Act; and
 - (iii) for the 2003/2004 financial year as indicated in the Schedule;
- (b) determine that-
 - (i) traditional leaders shall be entitled to the salaries as set out in the Schedule;
 - (ii) members of the National House of Traditional Leaders shall, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders, be entitled to an allowance in respect of actual meetings of the National House of Traditional Leaders, or a committee thereof, and seminars, workshops and conferences attended on behalf of the National House of Traditional Leaders as set out in the Schedule; and

- (iii) members of a provincial House of Traditional Leaders shall, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders, be entitled to an allowance in respect of actual meetings of the provincial House of Traditional Leaders concerned, or a committee thereof, and seminars, workshops and conferences attended on behalf of the provincial House of Traditional Leaders concerned, as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule–

"2003 12004 financial year" refers to the period 1 April 2003 to 31 March 2004.

2. The salaries payable to traditional leaders and the chairperson and deputy chairperson of the National House of Traditional Leaders (NHTL) are as follows:

Allowances payable to members of National House of Traditional Leaders for attending meetings of the House, seminars, workshops and conferences, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders

3. The allowances payable to members of the National House of Traditional Leaders for attending meetings of the National House, or a committee thereof, and seminars, workshops and conferences on behalf of the National House, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders, are as follows:

Category	Sitting Allowance	Subsistence Allowance	Transport Allowance
Member	R597.00 per day.	Reasonable, actual expenses.	Department of Transport tariffs for the use of privately owned vehicles.

Allowances payable to members of provincial House of Traditional Leaders for attending meetings of the House, seminars, workshops and conferences, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders

4. The allowances payable to members of a provincial House of Traditional Leaders for attending meetings of that House or a committee thereof, and seminars, workshops and conferences on behalf of that House, in addition to their salaries as traditional leaders, are as follows:
