NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 27 OF 1996)

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON A MINISTERIAL COMMITTEE RESPONSIBLE FOR MATHEMATICS AND MATHEMATICAL LITERACY

I Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor Minister of Education, hereby in terms of Section 3(4)(d) of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996), relating to innovation, research and development in education, approved the establishment of a Ministerial Project Committee of mathematicians and mathematics educators to conduct the empirical assessment on Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy.

- 2. The Committee will assess the levels of complexity of Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy, to determine whether Mathematical Literacy is indeed at an acceptable level for entry into certain programmes in higher education.
- The scope of the Committee will be in three key areas that require attention with 3. regard to Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy.
 The Committee will investigate and report on the following issues:
 - > The level of complexity of Mathematics;
 - > The level of complexity of Mathematical Literacy;
 - > The extent to which specific levels of attainment in Mathematical Literacy should provide access into certain programmes that do not require knowledge of abstract Mathematical concepts; and
 - > The implications for implementation.





- The Committee is expected to submit a Report in February 2005 on all aspects of Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy.
