## **Explanatory Memorandum to the Municipal Allocations set out in Schedules 3, 4, 6, and 7**

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009) and provides information on additional allocations and adjustments to existing allocations to municipalities in the 2009/10 national financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to allocate funds that have been rolled over in terms of Section 28(2)(a) of the 2008 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 2 of 2008) and the need to allocate additional funds to municipalities, as approved in terms of the 2009 Adjustments Appropriation Act (Act No. 21 of 2009). It is also necessitated by the need to re-allocate funds in terms of Section 29 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009).

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was originally published in *Government Gazettes* No. 32 106 of 03 April 2009 and No. 32 142 of 17 April 2009. The introductory information provided in the former gazettes thus applies equally to this *Gazette*, and is not repeated here.

This notice affects the following grant programmes:

- a) Water Services Operating Subsidy grant: In compliance with Section 22 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009), the national Department of Water Affairs is technically moving allocations to the value of R107.3 million, from Schedule 6 to Schedule 7, following the delay in finalisation of transfer agreements with certain municipalities.
- b) R53.7 million for the Municipal Drought Relief grant is made available to the Western Cape municipalities. The programme aims to compensate the municipalities for managing harsh conditions caused by drought. The grant will be administered by the national Department of Water Affairs.
- c) Municipal Infrastructure Grant: Roll-over of R287.8 million for funds that were stopped in 2008/09 financial year, this follows from slow spending in some municipalities. The programme is administered by the national Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs.
- d) Further, R60.8 million is provided through the disaster relief funding to be administered by the national Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs. The grant is gazetted as part of the Municipal Infrastructure Grant programme.
- e) The allocation of R12.2 million unallocated funds under the Local Government Financial Management grant is now allocated.
- f) The national Department of Minerals and Energy and Eskom are re-allocating funds between municipalities, under the Integrated National Electrification Programme. Slow spending by municipalities and unavailability of houses to electrify was the main reason for the decision to re-allocate between municipalities.

- g) The Neighbourhood Development Partnership grant (capital programme) administered by the National Treasury is reduced by R30.6 million to allow for increased attention to planning issues by municipalities to facilitate better project implementation and the provision of appropriate technical capacity. The amount of R30.6 million is thus re-allocated to Schedule 7 (in-kind) resulting in a net overall effect.
- h) An additional amount of R509 million is available through the Local Government Equitable Share. This additional funding seeks to compensate the municipalities for the impact of the additional salary adjustments for the 2009/10 financial year.

**NB:** Municipalities are requested to effect adjustments to their projections of grant income from these programmes accordingly, through the passing of a municipal adjustments budget.
