Appropriation of adjusted amounts of money for requirements of State

1.Subject to the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. I of 1999), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State 5 in respect of the financial year ending on 31 March 2003, the adjusted amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

2. This Act is called the Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2002
