In these regulations, "the Regulations" means The Merchant Shipping (Radio Installations) Regulations (2002) published by Government Notice No. R 506 on the 26th April 2002 and Government Notice No. R. 457 on the 2nd July 2013, as amended.

Amendment of Part 3, Non-Solas Requirements

 Regulation 22 of Merchant Shipping (Radio Installations) Regulations, 2002is hereby amended by

the insertion of sub-regulation (2A) after subregulation (2) of the subregulation:— "(2A) Additional requirement for certain ships to which this Part applies, being—

(i) a class D fishing vessel;

(ii) a cargo ship of less than 100 gross tonnage making a voyage less than 40 nautical miles from shore,

and must be provided with the satellite EPIRB of the kind referred to in regulation 10(1) (f)."

Short title and commencement

These regulations are called The Merchant Shipping (Radio Installations) Amendment Regulations, 2015 and are published for comments.
