CALL FOR COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT POLICY ON THE EVALUATION OF CREATIVE OUTPUTS AND INNOVATIONS PRODUCED BY PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, 2015

I, Bonginkosi Emmanuel Nzimande, Minister of Higher Education and Training, hereby publish the *Draft Policy on the Evaluation of Creative Outputs and Innovations produced by Public Higher Education Institutions* (2015) for public comments.

The purpose of the draft policy is to outline criteria for assessment and recognition for subsidy purposes, of scholarly outputs from the creative and performing arts produced by public higher education institutions in South Africa. The specified outputs in terms of this policy are: Fine Arts and Visual Arts; Music; Theatre, Performance and Dance; Design and Architecture; Film and Television; Literary Arts and Innovations.
