MARINE LIVING RESOURCES ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1998)

DURATION OF SMALL-SCALE FISHING RIGHTS

In terms of section 79 (1)(a) of the Marine Living Resources Act 18 of 1998 (MLRA), the Minister may upon the conditions that he or she deems fit, delegate any or all the powers conferred upon him or her in terms of this Act, save a power to make regulations, to the Director-General or an officer of the Department nominated by the Director-General. The Minister has delegated section 18 of the MLRA to the Deputy Director-General: Fisheries Management.

The Delegated Authority has, after due consideration, decided that a precautionary approach is required in implementing the new small-scale fishery and in so doing the duration of a small-scale fishing right shall be for a maximum of three years, and the Delegated Authority may only once at the expiration of such a period extend the period of validity of the right for a further period not exceeding two years on such conditions as she may impose.

In terms of the provisions of section 80 of the MLRA and Regulation 5 of the Regulations promulgated in terms thereof, an affected party may within 30 days of publication of this notice, appeal to the Minister against the decision to grant small-scale fishing rights for a period of three years with an option to extend the validity of the right for a further period not exceeding two years.
