CALL TO ACTION

VOTE OF NO CONFIDENCE IN ZUMA

On Madiba's birthday, over 600 people representing 130 organisations of our people gathered at the Rhema Bible Church at the Conference for a Future South Africa.

The Conference resolved on a number of issues to fight state capture, corruption and to reclaim South Africa.

The first resolution was to make an immediate call for united action to demand the resignation of Zuma as part of a longer struggle to defend our democracy.

We demand that our MPs vote Jacob Zuma out of power on August 8th. But no matter the parliamentary outcome the people must send a strong message to parliament and the world that the capture of our state must fall. Social justice, accountability and people's democracy must rise again. The struggle continues beyond 8 August 2017.

We call on our fellow South Africans to act now!!

As individuals we can:

- a. Write to members of parliament calling on them to vote YES in the motion of no confidence

In our organisations we should:

Before 8 August 2017:

- Build unity across sectors in your community and coordinate action against state capture and corruption
- In places of worship, at schools and universities and in our workplaces - organise mock ballots to send a peoples messages on the peoples view on the VONC. Use social media to publicise the outcome of the ballot
- Organise community meetings, put up posters and banners to create awareness on state capture and corruption.

Conference for the Future of South Africa

On 8 August 2017 we must:

- Join the protests outside parliament or protests closest to you
- Join nationwide demonstrations in your community, at work and places of learning. Watch out for details of these demonstrations.
- Post pictures of your protests on social media, using hashtags “#ReclaimingSA”

Beyond 8 August 2017 ready your organisation to:

- a. Unite with other organisations at local, regional and national level to reclaim our democracy and support campaigns to end poverty, inequality, unemployment and gender based violence.
- b. Support the work of organisations that are challenging corruption and state capture in the courts.
- c. Engage with our public representatives, local councils, provincial legislatures, parliament, Chapter 9 institutions to bring back integrity to our public institutions
- d. Support public servants and others who speak out against corruption and face victimization and harassment.

Join a united people’s struggle against state capture. The future of South Africa depends on it.
