## **THE INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY OF SOUTH AFRICA**

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa has, under section 67(8) of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005), made the regulations in the schedule.

### **SCHEDULE**

#### **1. Definitions**

In these regulations, “the Regulations” means the regulations published by Government Notice No. 38042 of 2014, as amended by Government Notice No. 41132 of 2017.

#### **2. Amendment of regulation 3 of the Regulations**

Regulation 3 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub-regulation:

“(c) The market definitions contained in this regulation do not include internationally originated voice traffic terminating on a mobile and/or fixed location within the Republic of South Africa.”

### **3. Short title and commencement**

These regulations are called the Call Termination Second Amendment Regulations, 2017 and will come into effect upon publication in the Government Gazette.
