NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION OF DURBANVILLE COLLEGE (PTY) LTD AS A PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION

I, Gwebinkundla Felix Qonde, Director-General of the Department of Higher Education and Training, hereby, in terms of section 63(a) of the *Higher Education Act, 1997 (Act No. 101 of 1997)* ("the Act") and Regulation 17(3) of the *Regulations for the Registration of Private Higher Education Institutions, 2016* ("the Regulations"), give notice of intent to cancel the registration of *Durbanville College (Pty) Ltd* as a private higher education institution. Regulation 17(1) stipulates that:

"Subject to sections 62 and 63 of the Act, the Registrar must cancel the registration or provisional registration of an institution if-

- (a) the institution ceases to-
 - (i) provide higher education as contemplated in the Act; and
 - (v) operate or terminate all its programmes."

On 31 January 2017, *Durbanville College (Pty) Ltd* informed the Department that it wishes to to discontinue its currently approved programmes.

Therefore, the reasons for my notice of intent to cancel the institution's registration is that *Durbanville College (Pty) Ltd* has ceased to meet the requirements for registration as required by section 1 of the Act.
