SOUTH AFRICAN QUALIFICATIONS AUTHORITY

PUBLIC NOTICE BY NSB 09, HEALTH SCIENCES AND SOCIAL SERVICES, OF AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER AN SGB FOR INTEGRATED HEALTH PROFESSIONS (THERAPEUTIC AROMATHERAPY, THERAPEUTIC REFLEXOLOGY AND THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE).

NSB 09 has received an application to recognise and register an SGB for Integrated Health Professions (Therapeutic Aromatherapy, Therapeutic Reflexology and Therapeutic Massage).

PROPOSED BRIEF OF THE SGB

- 1. Develop career pathways for the Integrated Health Professions in Therapeutic Aromatherapy, Therapeutic Reflexology and Therapeutic Massage from level 5 to level 8, which may also develop from those of Hairdressing Cosmetology and Beauty at NQF levels 2 4. to enable these professionals to be Registered by the Chiropractors, Homoeopaths and Allied Health Service Professions Council [Regulation 24 (1) (e)].
- 2. Generate the following unit standards-based qualifications and qualifications in accordance with Authority requirements:
 - 2.1 National Certificate in Theraneutic Aromatherapy or Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage
 - 2.2 National Diploma in Therapeutic Aromatherapy or Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage
 - 2.3 National First Degree in Therapeutic Aromatherapy or Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage
 - 2.4 Master's Degree in Therapeutic Aromatherapy or Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage
 - 2.5 Doctorate in Therapeutic Aromatherapy or Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage. [Regulation 24 (1) (a)].
- 3. Recommend the qualifications and pathways in 1 and 2 above to NSB 09 [Regulation 24 (1) (c)].
- 4. Review and update the proposed and subsequent qualifications and standards in Therapeutic Aromatherapy, Therapeutic Reflexology or Therapeutic Massage, as required [Regulation 24 (1) (b)].
- 5. Perform such other functions as may from time to time be delegated by NSB 09 (Health Sciences and Social Services) [Regulation 24 (1)(e)].
