NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE THE TRANSPORT APPEAL TRIBUNAL AMENDMENT BILL, 2020 INTO PARLIAMENT IN TERMS OF RULE 241(1) (b) OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The Minister of Transport hereby in terms of National Assembly Rule No. 241(1) (b) intends introducing the Transport Appeal Tribunal Amendment Bill, 2020 ("the Bill") in Parliament during 2020.

The Bill and its Explanatory Memorandum were published for comments in the Government Gazette No. 41202, Notice Number 1137 of 27 October 2017.

The object of the Bill is as follows:-

The object of the Bill is to amend the Transport Appeal Tribunal Act, 1998, so as to define certain words and expressions and to delete and amend certain definitions; to bring the Act in line with the developments since the implementation of the Act; to provide for certain powers of the Transport Appeal Tribunal; to allow the Minister to extend the term of office of the members of the Tribunal; to empower the Transport Appeal Tribunal to take appropriate steps in cases where its rulings are not implemented or effected timeously and empower it to investigate delays in the completion of its proceedings; and to provide for matters connected therewith.
