SOUTH AFRICAN QUALIFICATIONS AUTHORITY (SAQA)

PUBLIC NOTICE BY NSB 03, BUSINESS, COMMERCE AND MANAGEMENT STUDIES, OF AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER AN SGB FOR PROCUREMENT, LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

NSB 03 has received an application to recognise and register an SGB for Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management.

PROPOSED BRIEF OF THE SGB

- 1. Identify transformation, development and equity issues relevant to the sub-field Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management in NQF organising field 03 and develop mechanisms to include these issues within standards and qualifications as envisaged in 2 below [Regulation 24(1)(e)].
- 2. Generate unit standards-based qualifications and qualifications at NQF levels 1 to 8 relating to Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management in the areas of Purchasing Management and Practices, Supply Chain Management, International Trade, Procurement, Customs Clearing and Freight Forwarding, Logistics:
 - Certificates in Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management (Levels 1 4)
 - Diplomas in Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management (Level 5)
 - Bachelors Degrees in Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management (Level 6)
 - Honours Degrees in Procurement, Logistics and Supply Chain Management (Level 7)
 - Masters and Doctoral Degrees in Procurement and Supply Chain Management (Levels 8) [Regulation 24(1)(a)].
- 3. Liaise with all other SGBs in the field whose briefs mandate them to generate management standards and qualifications, as well as the SGB for Transport, Operations and Logistics in NSB 11 [Regulation 24(1)(a) & (e)].
- 4. Recommend the standards generated in 2, above, to National Standards Body 03 [Regulation 24(1)(c)].
- 5. Recommend criteria for the registration of assessor and moderators or moderating bodies [Regulation 24(1)(d).
- 6. Accept and perform other related functions as requested by NSB 03 [Regulation 24(1)(e)].
