## PROCLAMATION NOTICE 46 OF 2021

**AMENDMENTS TO THE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE COMMISSION OF  
INQUIRY INTO ALLEGATIONS OF STATE CAPTURE, CORRUPTION AND  
FRAUD IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR INCLUDING ORGANS OF STATE**

I hereby, under section 1 of the Commissions Act, 1947 (Act No. 8 of 1947), and by means of this Proclamation amend the Terms of Reference of the Commission of Inquiry into allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Sector including Organs of State in order to give effect to the judgment in the matter *between Chairperson of the Judicial Commission of Inquiry into allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Sector including Organs of State and the President of the Republic of South Africa And Others* (Case No: 1/2021) as indicated in the attached Schedule.

### Definition

1. In this Proclamation "Terms of Reference" means the terms of reference published under Proclamation No. 3 of 2018 in published in the Government Gazette No. 41403 of 2 January 2018 as amended by Proclamation No. 34 of 2018, No. 18 of 2020, No. 12 of 2021 and No. 31 of 2021.

### Amendment of the Terms of Reference

2. The Terms of Reference is hereby amended by the substitution of paragraph five (5) of the following paragraph"

"5. The Commission shall submit its report and recommendations to the President within **[180 days]** within a period two months calculated from 1 January 2022."
