## BUSA'S REACTION TO PRESIDENT CYRIL RAMAPHOSA'S ADDRESS LAST NIGHT

BUSA welcomes the ongoing downward trend in Covid infections and the advice of the health experts to the President to lighten some of the restrictions. We particularly welcome the lifting of requirements for a PCR test for incoming visitors and returning South Africans provided proof of a valid vaccination is provided. This will be a significant boost to Tourism and will also make it easier for vaccinated South Africans to travel.
