I, Nkosazana Clarice Dlamini Zuma, Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, under section 18(4) of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998), as amended, and after consulting the MECs responsible for local government in the provinces, determined the policy framework for the designation of full-time councillors, as set out in the Schedule.

The member of the Executive Council of a province responsible for local government may determine that councillors who have been elected or appointed to any of the following offices in a municipal council, may be designated as full-time:

- Speaker;
- Executive Mayor;
- Mayor;
- Deputy Executive Mayor;
- Deputy Mayor;
- A member of an Executive Committee other than the Mayor and Deputy Mayor;
- A member of a Mayoral Committee;
- Chairperson of a Sub-Council;
- Chairperson of a Committee established in terms of section 79;
- Chairperson of the Municipal Public Accounts Committee; and
- Whip.

**CATEGORY B MUNICIPALITIES**

- Speaker;
- Executive Mayor;
- Mayor;
- Deputy Executive Mayor;
- Deputy Mayor;
- A member of an Executive Committee other than the Mayor and Deputy Mayor;
- A member of a Mayoral Committee;
- Chairperson of a Committee established in terms of section 79 in municipalities with 40 or more councillors;
- Chairperson of the Municipal Public Accounts Committee; and
- Whip appointed for council in municipalities with 40 or more councillors.

**CATEGORY C MUNICIPALITIES**

- Speaker;
- Executive Mayor;
- Mayor;
- Deputy Executive Mayor;
- Deputy Mayor;
- A member of an Executive Committee other than the Mayor and Deputy Mayor;
- A member of a Mayoral Committee;
- Chairperson of a Committee established in terms of section 79 in municipalities with 40 or more councillors;
- Chairperson of the Municipal Public Accounts Committee; and
- Whip appointed for council in municipalities with 40 or more councillors.
