AMENDMENTS AGREED TO

CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA AMENDMENT BILL [B 49—97]

CLAUSE 1

Clause rejected.

NEW CLAUSE

1. That the following be a new Clause 1:

Amendment of section 90 of Act 108 of 1996

1. Section 90 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection:

“(4) A person who as Acting President has sworn or affirmed faithfulness to the Republic need not repeat the swearing or affirming procedure for any subsequent term as Acting President during the period ending when the person next elected President assumes office.”.

CLAUSE 2

1. On page 2, from line 19, to omit “, if designated by the President of the Constitutional Court, the Deputy President of that Court or a Judge President of the High Court” and to substitute:

another judge designated by the President of the Constitutional Court

CLAUSE 3

1. On page 2, from line 25, to omit subitem (2) and to substitute:

“(2) For the purposes of subitem (1), the date ‘6 December 1993’, where it appears in the provisions of the previous Constitution under the heading ‘National Unity and Reconciliation’, must be read as ‘11 May 1994’.”.

CLAUSE 4

1. On page 3, in line 3, to omit, “is deemed to have come into operation” and to substitute:

must be regarded as having taken effect
