

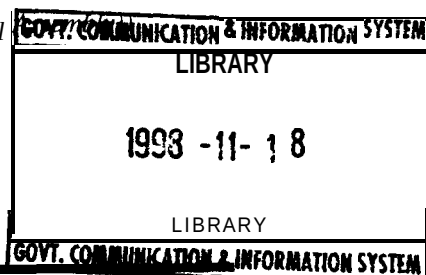

CRIMINAL PROCEDURE AMENDMENT BILL
[B 132–98]

CLAUSE 1

1. In the English text, on page 2, in line 6, to omit “young”.
2. On page 2, in line 8, to omit “Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any law and”.
3. On page 2, in line 10, to omit “72(l)(b)” and to substitute “72”.
4. In the Afrikaans text, on page 3, in line 20, after “hof”, to insert “na inhegtenisname”.
5. In the Afrikaans text, on page 3, in line 25, after “is;”, to insert “en”.
6. In the English text, on page 4, in line 1, to omit “been”.
7. On page 4, in line 27, to omit “secure”.
8. On page 4, in line 35, after “place”, to insert:

where it is practicable to do so
9. In the Afrikaans text, on page 5, in line 52, after “persoon”, to insert “in kennis te stel”.
10. In the Afrikaans text, on page 5, in line 59, to omit “is” and to substitute “word”.
11. On page 6, in line 25, to omit “secure”.
12. In the Afrikaans text, on page 7, in line 46, to omit “gemaak” and to substitute “geneem”.
13. On page 6, after line 54, to insert:

(c) the age of the person, particularly if he or she is under the age of 14 years;
14. On page 8, in line 54, to omit “provided for in section 3 of” and to substitute “contemplated in”.
15. In the English text, on page 10, in line 1, to omit “subsections” and to substitute “subsection”.
16. On page 10, in line 19, to omit “an awaiting-trial prisoner, before conviction or sentencing” and to substitute:

awaiting trial and who has not been sentenced

CLAUSE 2

1. On page 12. in line 7, to omit “Items” and to substitute “Item”,

CLAUSE 4

1. In the Afrikaans text, on page 13, in line 31, to omit the second “(c)” and to substitute “(b)”.

CLAUSE 5

1. On page 12, in line 40, to omit “alleged to have” and to substitute “accused of having”.
2. On page 12, in line 40, to omit “mentioned” and to substitute “referred to”.
