CLAUSE 4

1. On page 2, in line 33, to omit “eleven” and to substitute “nine”.
2. On page 2, in line 33, to omit “seven” and to substitute “five”.
3. On page 2, in line 35, to omit “of a” and to substitute “in every”.
4. On page 4, after line 3, to insert the following new paragraph:
 - (b) The Minister must invite nominations for persons to be appointed to the Tribunal through a notice published in at least two newspapers circulating countrywide.

CLAUSE 5

1. On page 4, in line 12, to omit “another as the deputy chairperson of the Tribunal” and to substitute:

the Tribunal shall, at its first sitting, from among its number elect a deputy chairperson

CLAUSE 9

1. On page 6, in line 4, to omit “three” and to substitute “fifty per cent of the”.

CLAUSE 16

1. On page 10, in line 20, after “Director-General” to insert:

as accounting officer of the Tribunal

CLAUSE 17

1. On page 10, in line 39, after “appeal” to insert:

, including the manner in which the tribunal must give notification of its sittings
2. On page 10, after line 47, to insert the following new paragraph:
 - (f) requiring members to declare any financial or personal interest in respect of matters related to the functions of the Tribunal which may affect the impartiality of members;

CLAUSE 19

1. On page 12, in line 23, to omit “and commencement”.
2. On page 12, from line 24, to omit “, and will come into operation on 1 April 1998”.
