GAMBLING MATTERS AMENDMENT BILL
[B 33—99]

CLAUSE 1

1. On page 2, from line 4, to omit all the words after “amended” up to and including “words” in line 6 and to substitute:
 - (a) by the substitution for paragraph (f) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph
2. On page 2, in line 7, before the first “the” to insert “(f)”.
3. On page 2, in line 13, to omit “or”.
4. On page 2, after line 13, to insert:
 - (ii) in the case of any organisation the founding law of which is administered by the provincial sphere of government and the shares of which may only be disposed of by the national sphere of government or with the consent or approval of that sphere of government, from a date determined by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*,” or
5. On page 2, after line 14, to add:
 - (b) by the insertion after paragraph (f) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph:

“(fA) a provincial licensing authority shall, notwithstanding paragraph (f), disregard any financial interest in any gambling activity held by the State, an organ of State or any organisation with which the State is concerned when considering an application for a licence contemplated in paragraph (j) before—

 - (i) the date contemplated in paragraph (f)(i), if that financial interest is held by the national sphere of government or any organisation referred to in paragraph (f)(i) or (ii); or
 - (ii) 10 May 1999, in any other case;”.

LONG TITLE

1. On page 2, in the fifth line, after “activity;” to insert:

to further regulate the date until when a provincial licensing authority shall disregard certain financial interest when considering an application for a casino licence;
